Roald Dahl

Roald Dahl is the author of such famous children's stories as *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* and *The Big Friendly Giant* . When I went to visit Roald Dahl last month, I was curious to find out where the writer of so many wonderfully clever and creative stories spends each day.

This is what he told me about his daily routine:

Every morning, summer and winter, he leaves the house, walks down the garden and shuts himself up in a plain white-painted wooden hut, heated only by an ancient paraffin heater and a single-bar electric fire hanging from the ceiling, which is directed at his hands. There is a dirty plastic curtain at the window and the floor is covered with dust and rubbish.

'No one can come in here except me so the place hasn't been cleaned for years.' he smiles.

He always writes in pencil on yellow paper, and reads every sentence aloud to see if it sounds right.

"All I need are these six yellow pencils in this jar here and this automatic pencil sharpener is vital. So my thermos flask of coffee which I sip from all the time I'm working. I'm in the hut from 10-12.30 , then I go for lunch and a rest and come back for another two hours in the afternoon. And that's it !"
