Edson Arantes do Nascimento - better known as Pelé!

Brought up in a very poor family in Tres Coracoes, Brazil, Pelé today is a rich man. A member of the National Soccer Hall of Fame and a footballing legend, he is considered by many to be the best player ever to kick a football, and is known all over the world.

He wasn't always rich and famous though, and used to practise football as a child with a sock stuffed with newspapers - that's how poor the family was! Pelé learnt how to play football from his father, Dondinho, who was himself a very good centre forward until his career ended because he broke his leg. Through his father he started to play for a minor-league club when he was a young teenager. He was lucky enough to be discovered at the age of 11 by one of Brazil's most famous players, Waldemar de Brito. Brito took Pelé to Sao Paulo where he told the directors of the club that Pelé could be the greatest soccer player in the world.

Of course the directors didn't believe him, but he turned out to be right. In his first game for them, at the age of 16, he scored a goal after being on the pitch only a few minutes.

Pelé went on to play for the Brazilian National Team, taking part in four World Cups. He nearly missed the World Cup in Sweden in 1958, because he had a knee injury. But he played and scored six goals, including two in the final to help Brazil beat Sweden. Brazil won 5-2 and Pelé was only 17 years old at the time!

Many people have wondered why he never played for a club outside Brazil. In fact, many European clubs offered a lot of money to sign him, but the Brazilian government made Pelé an official national treasure to stop him from being transferred out of the country.

The goal that Pelé speaks about the most out of the 1280 that he's scored is the one he scored at the 1970 World Cup finals in Mexico, when Brazil beat Italy 4-1.

Pelé scored what was Brazil's 100th World Cup goal, but he scored it with his head. His father once scored five goals in a game, all with his head and it was a record Pelé was never able to break. He certainly broke many others though, and more than deserves the title of *legend*.
